In November, our weekly tips aim to inspire and equip travelling dads. This week, we're sharing some tips on how you can have fun while preparing your kids for your time apart. Try these tips to familiarise your children with the idea of you being away.

- **Research your destination with your kids.** Use your upcoming trip as a chance to spend quality time with your kids and teach them something new. Get online and research your destination: show them where it is on a map; see how far it is from your home; find out what the weather is like there; pinpoint famous landmarks.
- **Let your children help you pack.** Another way to connect with your kids before you leave is to let them help you pack. You can ask them things like "What do you think I should bring?" "How many pairs of socks do I need?" Let them put things in your bag, and use it as an opportunity to teach them how to pack a suitcase properly.

Did You Know?

Almost 3 in every 100 children have a peanut allergy.

Even trace amounts of peanut or tree nuts can trigger an allergy and kill a child.

Anaphylaxis is a serious allergic reaction that can cause itchy rash, throat or tongue swelling, shortness of breath, vomiting, light-headedness, low blood pressure and cardiac arrest. Tragically, Australian children have died at school from nut allergies.

There are several children at Milton Public School who have a life-threatening nut allergy. Our school strongly encourages you to help minimise harm to those students by **not sending nuts or nut products to school.**






