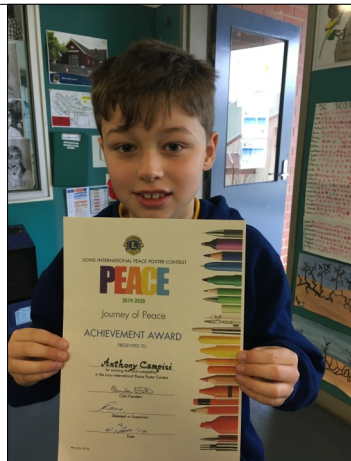

## Influenza, Coughs and Colds

Please ensure that your child stays away from school if they are sick so that they do not spread viruses. Please remind your child to wash their hands after toileting and before and after eating. Coughing into the crook of your arm or into a tissue that is discarded into the bin is important.

### Cough etiquette

#### Cover your cough



- When coughing or sneezing, use a tissue to cover your nose and mouth
- Dispose of the tissue afterwards
- If you don't have a tissue, cough or sneeze into your elbow.

#### Wash your hands



- After coughing, sneezing or blowing your nose, wash your hands with soap and water
- Use alcohol-based hand cleansers if you do not have access to soap and water

Remember hand washing is the single most effective way to reduce the spread of germs that cause respiratory disease.

Anyone with signs and symptoms of a respiratory infection, regardless of the cause, should be instructed to cover their mouth/nose when coughing or sneezing. Use tissues to contain respiratory secretions, dispose of tissues in the nearest waste receptacle after use, and wash their hands afterwards.

### The Fathering Project

In September, our weekly tips aim to inspire and equip separated dads. This week, we are taking a look at the importance of being involved, no matter what is happening with your parental partner.

#### Be involved.

- Make sure to keep track of the key things that are happening in your children's life – even when you're apart.
- Send small messages or make phone calls to remind them of your love, support and presence. Small thoughts and wishes like "good luck with your exam today" or "train hard at soccer tonight" are simple but meaningful ways to reassure your child that you're still attentive to what's going on for them.
- Continuing to attend parent/teacher interviews, sporting events, dance classes, plays and your child's other important events helps to show that you will always be there, no matter what.
- Other opportunities to 'be there' are volunteering at their school, using your phone to check-in regularly and remind them that you're thinking of them.
- When schedules clash; still put in an effort to celebrate the special days like birthdays, graduating school or father's day; even if sometimes it is not on the actual date.

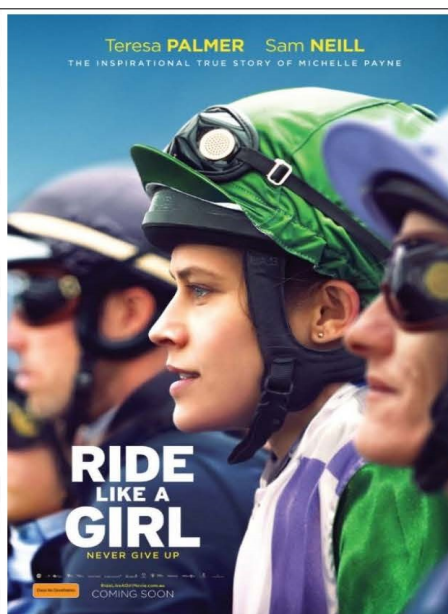
