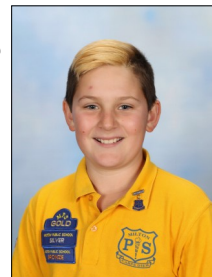

Your child will be given a Parent Information Kit in the first few weeks of Term 1, 2021, which contains information about the vaccines and a consent card that you will need to complete for the vaccines to be offered.

7	Diphtheria-Tetanus-Pertussis (dTpa)	1-dose
	Human Papillomavirus (HPV)	2-dose schedule (6months apart)
